

ADVERTISEMENT AND INVITATION FOR BIDS

Bee County will receive bids for backup generators to be installed by PMUD at the Water and Wastewater Treatment Facilities in Pettus, TX for Bee County's U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery ("CDBG-DR") funds, Contract No. 20-065-016-C056 administered by the Texas General Land Office ("GLO") for damage sustained from Hurricane Harvey until 2:00 PM on Thursday December 3rd at 111 South St. Mary's, Suite 101 Beeville, Texas 78102. Bids must be addressed to: Apri Cantu, Bee County Auditor's Office (RFP # 20/21-003). The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:15 PM on Thursday, December 3rd at 105 W. Corpus Christi St., Commissioners Court Rm 110, Beeville, Texas 78102.

An optional pre-bid meeting will be held on November 17th at 10:00 AM at 105 W Corpus Christi St., Commissioners Court Rm 110, Beeville, Texas 78102. The deadline for questions will be November 18th at 5:00 PM, and all questions will be answered with an addendum that will be issued the following day.

Bids are invited for several Base Bid items as follows:

- (1) Industrial Diesel 60 KW Generator
- (1) Industrial Diesel 80 KW Generator

Bids are invited for Additive Bid items as follows:

- (1) Delivery of 60 KW Generator to Water Plant in Pettus, TX
- (1) Delivery of 80 KW Generator to Wastewater Plant in Pettus, TX

Bid/Contract Documents, including Drawings and Technical Specifications are on file at ICE at 261 Saratoga Blvd, Corpus Christi, TX 78417. Copies of the Bid/Contract Documents may be obtained by depositing \$100 with International Consulting Engineers for each set of documents obtained. The deposit will be refunded if the documents and drawings are returned in good condition within 10 days following the bid opening.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to Bee County or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

The project will be financed with assistance from the General Land Office (GLO) under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) program and is subject to all applicable Federal and State laws and regulations. The successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or national origin.

All contractors and subcontractors must be cleared (not suspended or debarred) prior to any formal action authorizing the award of a contract to the contractor. Minority Business Enterprises, Small Business Enterprises, Women Business Enterprises, Section 3 Businesses, and labor surplus area firms are encouraged to submit bids.

Bee County reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by Bee County for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.
