ORDER ESTABLISHING ELECTRONIC COURT DOCKET

WHEREAS, Rule 26, *Rules of Civil Procedure*; Section 26.004, *Government Code*; and Section 52.003, *Estates Code* all provide for the creation and maintenance of a court docket; and,

WHEREAS, those and perhaps other statutes require this Court to make docket entries in its Court Minutes; and,

WHEREAS, the County Clerk, as record keeper of this court, has access to an electronic court management system and,


WHEREAS, this electronic court management system provides all of the necessary record keeping required for the criminal, civil, and probate cases on file in this court after January 1, 1999; and,

WHEREAS, those electronic records shall provide accurate copies of all orders and judgments of this court; and,

WHEREAS, these records are preserved and backed up off-site for safety and preservation.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS SO ORDERED BY THE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY COURT OF BEE COUNTY, TEXAS that hereafter the old paper hardbound Docket Books for these functions will no longer be used and all records will be maintained electronically.
