CASE UPDATE

Total Bee County confirmed community cases (i.e. not TDCJ inmates): **1,339**

Total new cases reported today: **37**

On November 6, 2020, DSHS notified Bee County of 8 additional community cases. On November 7, 2020, DSHS notified Bee County of 1 additional community case. On November 9, 2020, DSHS notified Bee County of 5 additional community cases. On November 10, 2020, DSHS notified Bee County of 8 additional community cases. On November 11, 2020, DSHS notified Bee County of 6 additional community cases. No new cases were reported on November 8 or 12, 2020. Also, on the 10th, DSHS also notified Bee County of 9 additional cases which are not new cases but are cases that were found in a backlog of old cases.
